

Nutcracker 2022 Info - Note 2

Dress Rehearsal: Tuesday December 6th 5:00-8:00pm @ Parsons Theater

Dancers have been sized for costumes and they will be passed out the week prior to dress rehearsal.

All dancers are expected to attend Dress Rehearsal as this is the ONLY chance for them to rehearse the entire production, including Finale all together. This is extremely important so that the dancers know the flow and timing of the show and what is to be expected for entrances and exits. Dancers need to check-in at 4:30pm, dressed and ready to perform. All dancers should have Pink tights, Pink Ballet (Boys are in white or black Ballet shoes) shoes and hair should be slicked back into a bun with NO bangs. All hair pieces should be worn. No jewelry please.

We will begin promptly at 5:00pm. No parents will be allowed to observe or stay to watch. Do not send any valuables, electronics or food. We will dismiss in this order:

Parents MUST come in to the Theater lobby to pick up their dancer. 7:30 dismissal: Ballet I (Chinese/Lambs), Ballet II (Lambs/Bon Bons), Ballet IIA (Snowballs, Candy Canes) 7:45 dismissal: Ballet I (Angels), Ballet III (Arabian), Ballet IV (Spanish), 8:00 dismissal: Ballet IVA (Snowflakes), Ballet V (Flowers), Princesses

Performances: Friday December 9th at 6:00pm & Saturday December 10th at 2:00pm

All dancers perform in <u>both shows</u>. Two performances allow for all friends and family to attend. Performances take place at Parsons Theater at the New Northglenn Recreation Center, located at 1 E. Memorial Parkway. Dancers need to arrive at the Theater 45 minutes prior to showtime and check in. Dancers must arrive ready with stage make-up on, no nail polish, or jewelry. Please do not bring valuables, electronics, or food to the Theater. The show

will last approximately 1 hour, give or take 15 minutes. There is NO Intermission.

Online ticket sales for the Nutcracker will go on sale starting November 21st through TUTUTIX (linked below). Tickets are reserved seating so purchase early if you desire specific seats. The show could sell out, purchase for immediate family first, then for family and friends as needed. Tickets are \$12.00 for Adults and \$8.00 for children under 12 years old. There is NO password required to purchase tickets. Tickets will not be sold in person at the studio or at the theater. This year we will offer a digital program only, no paper copies. Look for an email link the week before the shows.

Costumes must be returned after the performances. Dancers can return at the theater (they need to bring a change of clothes) OR they can return them during our last week of classes December 12th-17th during our Theme Week! Please remember ALL costume pieces must be returned in the garment bag/ baggie that it arrived in. If the costume is not returned or is returned damaged, you are responsible for replacement cost between \$25-\$60. If the costume is not returned in December a late fee of \$10 (for dry cleaning) will be charged and added to your account. Dancers do not get to keep the costumes as we intend to use them in future years.

Please note that there will be NO classes after December 17th (we do have class on Saturday December 17th). The studio will be closed from December 19th until January 1st, 2023. Classes will resume January 2nd, 2023.
