

Ballet and Jazz Placement

Each dancer is graded on a scale by several teachers. We look at each dancer individually and try to make a decision on what is best for them based on their ability, their age, and their personal learning style. We also only have a set number of spots in each level so our class sizes are manageable. We want every dancer to feel confident, and have the ability to grow in their training in a positive and healthy manner. We evaluate and discuss each dancer, based on our years of professional training and teaching experience.

We will post class placement results on our website and in the parent portal; Sunday August 7th, 2022.

Results will be listed by their number. Dancers in both Jazz and Ballet will have the same number. All placement results are final. You will need to still enroll (online or at the studio) during the scheduled enrollment date. We will NOT automatically enroll your dancer.

Enrollment for levels IIA-VI will begin on Monday, August 8th at NOON.

Please note enrollment for levels I, II, Combo, Hip Hop, Tap, Acrobat and Adult classes will begin on Monday July 25th at noon

REMINDER of Premier's requirements:

*Ballet Levels I, II, and IIA are required to attend one class per week.

*Ballet Levels III dancers must attend twice a week. Please choose either Mon/Wed OR Mon/Thur.

All Ballet 3 students must be enrolled in the Monday class to participate in the Nutcracker.

*Ballet Level IV dancers must attend twice a week. Please choose either Mon/Wed OR Mon/Thur.

All Ballet 4 students must be enrolled in the Monday class to participate in the Nutcracker.

*Ballet Level IVA must attend class twice per week.

Students in Ballet IVA will be evaluated for Pre-pointe readiness during the first week of Fall classes.

*Ballet Level V & VI dancers are required to take 3 classes per week.

Pointe levels are determined at placement and will be posted with class placement results.

*Dancers must be enrolled in either Ballet or Jazz class of the coinciding level in order to take Lyrical or Modern. If a dancer is split levels in Ballet & Jazz they may enroll in either level for Lyrical or Modern.

*All Jazz classes attend only once per week.

*Mixed Class is for dancers in levels IVA, V and VI only. Class consists of a variety of styles and will include occasional guest teachers. There are no performances for this class.
